Coral Restoration, Preservation, and Support in Tahiti

SHISEIDO is implementing the SHISEIDO BLUE PROJECT efforts to protect the oceans worldwide through sun care under the theme "Respect for Oceans." This is the second year of coral restoration and preservation efforts in Tahiti as part of this project. SHISEIDO is working to restore and preserve coral again this year before the competition as a WSL global sustainability partner in cooperation with WSL PURE, WSL One Ocean, WSL's nonprofit organizations, and Coral Gardeners, an organization working to protect the ocean. Coral preserved last year will be observed, and workshops on restoring the coral to good health will be held. Project ambassador Kanoa Igarashi and local children will also participate to convey the importance of protecting the coral ecosystem to the local community and surfers.

Donations will also be made through WSL PURE's grant program to support ongoing ocean preservation efforts. This funding will be used for coral restoration projects undertaken by Coral Gardeners. Coral is a symbol of Tahiti. By promoting improved awareness and participation in ocean preservation among the local community, we will help preserve and support the beautiful coral of Tahiti at the competition site.
